EIM General Assembly re-elects President and Vice-President

Today, the General Assembly of EIM unanimously re-elected as its President **Gorm Frimannslund**, CEO of the Norwegian Infrastructure Manager Bane NOR and as Vice-President **Alain Quinet**, Executive Director, Strategy & Corporate Affairs of the French Infrastructure Manager SNCF Réseau (FR).
